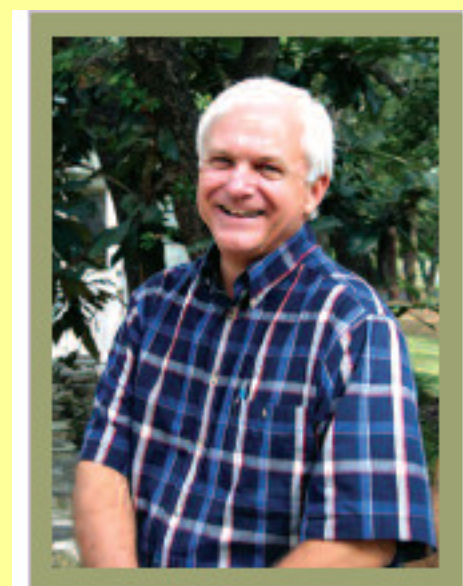

John received his D.Phil. degree in New Testament from the University of Oxford in 2004.*

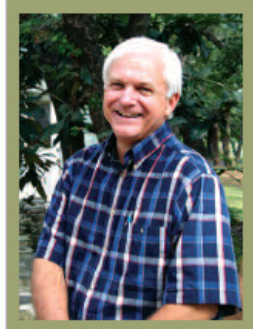
